- I agree to have my name and contact information released to the Healing Art Committee, Emily Carr, and the IDEA Art Award donors.
- I agree to have my name and art work used to promote the IDEA Art Award, the Healing Art Committee and Emily Carr in promotional materials, website, etc.

- I agree to allow my piece of art to be reproduced by the media to promote the IDEA Art Award, the Healing Art Committee and Emily Carr.
- I understand that if I do not agree to all of the above listed requirements I forfeit the opportunity to win the IDEA Art Award or have my work displayed.
- I have read the Overview and Context information on the IDEA Award and have given this due consideration when submitting my application.
- I have carefully read the eligibility criteria and I meet this criteria.

CRITERIA + CONSIDERATIONS:

- The location is the Detwiller Pavillion at UBC Hospital.
- The purpose and audience of artwork(s).
- Art work should inspire a positive, calm and hopeful mindset.
- Art work must be sturdy and significant in size.
- Art work must be able to be secured to a wall.
- Excessive use of red is discouraged.
- Obscene, provocative or otherwise questionable content will not be considered. Emily Carr and VGH & UBC Hospital Foundation retain sole discretion as to what constitutes inappropriate content.
- Entries will be judged and selected based on creativity, beauty, impact and how the piece(s) enliven and enrich the lives of patients, patients' families, doctors, nurses and other hospital personnel.

WINNER

A jury of respected art experts will select the winning piece(s) for the IDEA Art Competition. Finalists will be notified by phone and email to submit their original works for the final jury process.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- The competition winner must sign and agree with the terms outlined in the Submission Agreement which must be completed and submitted with a jpeg of the artwork as otherwise stated.
- If the jury is unable to select an appropriate piece of art work through the submissions received, the competition will be suspended until the following year, at which time another Call of Submissions will be distributed.
- Emily Carr and/or VGH and UBC Hospital Foundation reserves the right to disqualify any entrant that Emily Carr and/or VGH and UBC Hospital Foundation have reason to believe is not the original work of entrant, or does not otherwise meet the contest rules. If a winner is disqualified or determined to be ineligible, an alternate winner will be selected using the same judging process/criteria described above. Alternate winners are subject to all requirements set forth in these Official Rules.
- Emily Carr and/or VGH and UBC Hospital Foundation are entitled to interpret these rules as needed and their decisions are final.
