II. REPORTS

1. Vice President Academic + Provost's Report

Dr. David Bogen invited the Board to view the Imagining our Future website: http://imagining.ecuad.ca/ Imagining Our Future is a three year series of events and activities that explore the geographical, historical, and cultural context of Emily Carr University's anticipated move to the False Creek Flats.

David Bogen reported on recent visits and talks by Stephen Beal, President of California College of the Arts, Trudeau Fellow Janine Marcheussalt and a delegation from Willem de Kooning Academy. The talks are posted on the Imagining our Future site. David Bogen distributed the 8 Principles of Design for Relocation + Transformation information sheet to the Board. David Bogen further reported on the ongoing planning for the next academic year, faculty searches and recruitment, CRC Chair applications.

2. Vice President Enrolment + Student Services / Registrar's Report

Jennifer DeDominicis reported on the progress of admissions, faculty portfolio reviews, the increase in international undergraduate students and the intake to the Master of Design (Mdes) program. A newly formed Senate Admissions Committee is meeting regularly to review current and new admission standards, new initiatives for student recruitment and engagement. Jennifer DeDominicis further reported on the student and faculty advisory committee, the development of the Speak Easy Bureau and Critique tune up workshop. Jennifer DeDominicis invited the Board to attend the Opening of the Aboriginal Student Art Exhibition "Redaction" on Tuesday, March 18th at 6:00 pm in the Concourse Gallery at Emily Carr.

- 1. Alumni Association update Dave Humphrey, President, Alumni Association, reported on the addition of new members to the Alumni Association Board, the upcoming launch of new alumni chapters in Toronto, New York and San Francisco and new initiatives to improve engagement by Alumni. A social event for the members of the Alumni Association Board and the Board of Governors will be planned for Fall 2014. The Board expressed interest in further involvement and information sharing between the Boards and asked to be kept up to date regarding the launches of the new alumni chapters. The Board thanked Dave Humphrey for a very interesting report and for his enthusiastic work with the Alumni Association Board.
- 2. Lightbeam Amber Frid-Jimenez, Associate Professor, Faculty of Design + Dynamic Media, Faculty of Graduate Studies, reported on the development of Lightbeam, a Firefox add-on that uses interactive visualizations to show the tracking and collecting of profile information and show patterns of behavior on the Web. Lightbeam was developed in collaboration with Mozilla.
