RESOURCES + MATERIALS LIST: 2D ANIMATION

Due to the online nature of the program this year, students participating in SIT will be required to have their own access to the required software, hardware and materials for their registered studio.

Required hardware:

- Tablet or a smartphone to download and run Cateater.
- Computer with web cam. Computers should meet the following [minimum requirements](#) to run Adobe Animate.
- Headphones and microphone
- Suggested: Drawing tablet (Wacom, Huion) to create hand-drawn illustrations directly in Adobe Animate. Students may also use their iPads or tablets if they install [Duet Display](#) or [Astropad](#).
- **Note:** Please ensure that your tablet or smartphone have at least 8GB of free storage for your stop-motion projects. Your computer should have at least 16 GB of free storage for installation and temporary files, plus additional storage for your animation projects.

Required software:

- [Cateater Stop-Motion Studio](#)
- [Adobe Animate*](#) (previously known as Adobe Flash).
- [Adobe Premiere*](#) or similar video editing software.
- [Adobe Encoder*](#)

*Students will be provided access to temporary licenses to Adobe software, valid for the duration of the program. Please note that this temporary license will be linked to the student's email address, which may be stored in servers outside of Canada. Consent forms and instructions to activate the temporary software license will be provided in your Welcome Package.
