Required hardware:

- Computer with webcam. Computers should meet the following minimum requirements to run Adobe CC software.

- Suggested: Printer
- **Note:** Please ensure that your computer has at least 16 GB of free storage for your projects.

Required software:

- Adobe Photoshop*
- Adobe Illustrator*
- Adobe InDesign*

*Students will be provided access to temporary licenses to Adobe software, valid for the duration of the program. Please note that this temporary license will be linked to the student's email address, which may be stored in servers outside of Canada. Consent forms and instructions to activate the temporary software license will be provided in your Welcome Package.
