To be eligible for the Thelma Ruck Keene Memorial Award for Ceramics, you must complete and return this application by September 28, 2020. Only Ceramics students exhibiting in the Degree Exhibition may apply, and the recipient must agree to the terms outlined below.

Circle Craft Co-operative will provide a \$1,000 award to a graduate or undergraduate student majoring in **Ceramics**. A selection committee will choose the recipient, based on work in The Show, who demonstrates outstanding achievement in Ceramics.

The recipient of the Thelma Ruck Keene Memorial Award for Ceramics must supply a Ceramic piece for display at Circle Craft (approx. 30 days; date to be determined). This piece can be for display purposes only or it can be for sale at a price determined by the award recipient. If the item is for sale, Circle Craft will charge 45% commission on the sale. If the item is not for sale, Circle Craft will return the piece following the show.
