Emily Carr University Bursaries are awarded from a limited fund to students demonstrating financial need. In assessing applications, priority will be given to students who have found it necessary to borrow heavily in order to finance their education. Bursary funds are administered to **supplement**, not replace, other assistance. Bursaries are intended to help you through the last month of classes. Students who have not applied for need-based financial aid (student loans) will not normally be awarded bursaries.

Only **full-time students** registered at ECU for a minimum of 12 credits **each semester** during the 2019/2020 academic year are eligible to apply for these bursaries. Masters students must be registered in a minimum of 9 credits.
