Emily Carr co-presents Interactive Futures '11: Animal Influence.

VANCOUVER, BC | New media artists, scientists, activists and philosophers are gathering together at Emily Carr University of Art + Design for a unique look at how animal cognition, animal consciousness and animal agency are changing the way we make art, do science, make ethical choices and make change in the world with *Interactive Futures 2011: Animal Influence*. The conference features a workshop, concurrent exhibitions, performances and screenings that take place at Emily Carr and Gallery Gachet, November 17 - 19, 2011.

Keynote speakers include respected cognitive ethologist Marc Bekoff and international new media artist Lisa Jevbratt. The workshop features prominent international presenters; artists, researchers and experts, including Gay Bradshaw and Emily Carr Associate Professor Dr. Carol Gigliotti. Exhibitions include international and local artists exhibiting interactive and new media art works - Ecoarttech, Bryndis Snæbjörnsdóttir & Mark Wilson, Sam Easterson, France Cadet, Joanne Bristol, Iain Gardner, Merritt Johnson, Lisa Jevbratt and Emily Carr Associate Professor's Julie Andreyev, Chris Jones and Sandra Semchuk.

"*IF'11* brings together artists and researchers who are exploring the perceptual, emotional and imaginative spaces of animals," says Julie Andreyev, Artistic Director. "We're discussing how culture perceives and relates to animals, both negatively and positively, and how crucial it is that we expand our compassionate footprint. The art works, performances and screenings show how animals express and how they are creative agents. *IF'11* will focus on the vital questions and debates that need to happen if we care to respectfully co-exist with other species on this planet."
